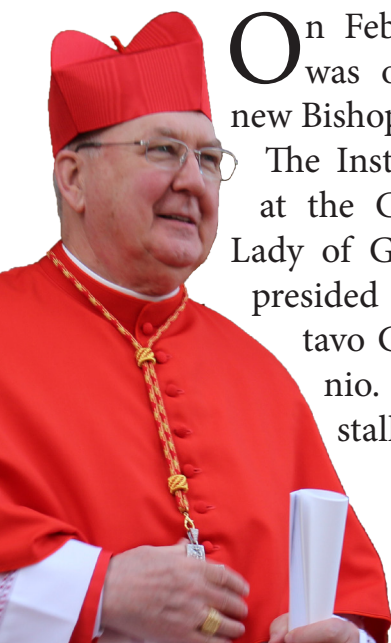

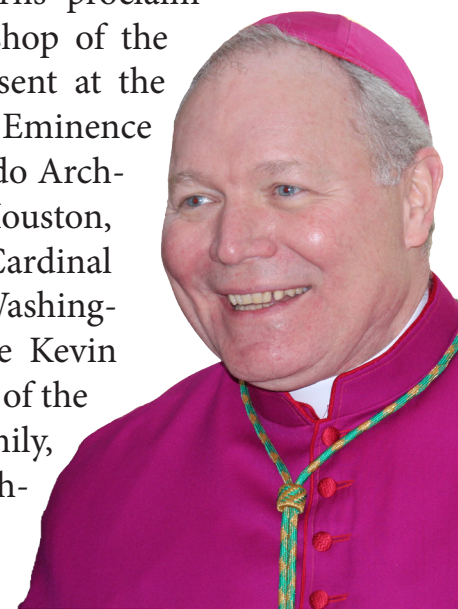


## Newsletter



On February 9<sup>th</sup>, Bishop Burns was officially installed as the new Bishop of the Diocese of Dallas. The Installation Mass took place at the Cathedral Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Dallas. It was presided over by Archbishop Gustavo García-Siller of San Antonio. During the liturgy of installation, the Nuncio to the United States, Christophe Pierre presented the Papal Bull, signed by Pope

Francis, to Bishop Burns proclaiming him the eighth bishop of the Diocese of Dallas. Present at the installation, were His Eminence Daniel Cardinal DiNardo Archbishop of Galveston, Houston, His Eminence Donald Cardinal Wuerl, Archbishop of Washington, and His Eminence Kevin Cardinal Farrell Prefect of the Dicastery for Laity, Family, and Life, the former Bishop of Dallas.





## BISHOP EDWARD J. BURNS

On the eve of the Installation Mass, on February 8<sup>th</sup>, the Diocese of Dallas gave a special welcome to our new bishop, Bishop Edward J. Burns at the Cathedral Shrine of the Virgin of Guadalupe. Bishop Burns presided at the Solemn Vespers accompanied by the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Dallas, Bishop Gregory Kelly, who will now return to his role as the Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Dallas.



Many of the faithful from the Diocese gathered together to welcome Bishop Burns. The formators and seminarians, from the Redemptoris Mater Seminary, were also present at the Installation Mass, together with a good number of the communities from the Neocatechumenal Way. We gave the new Bishop a warm welcome, showing our support for him as the new shepherd of the Diocese of Dallas.

## ADMISSIO AD ORDINES

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of January this year we were happy to witness both Michal Markiewicz, on the right, and Giuseppe Spoto, on the left, being Admitted to Candidacy for Sacred Orders. This is an important step in a seminarians path to final ordination as a priest. The seminarian publicly recognises the Lord is calling him and expresses his intention to receive ordination, first as a deacon and then to the priesthood.



The Church then, through the Bishop, publicly confirms this call and accepts them as candidates for Ordination. The mass was presided over by the Apostolic Administrator, Bishop Gregory Kelly. Michal Markiewicz and Giuseppe Spoto will then be ordained to the Diaconate the 20<sup>th</sup> of May 2017 by the new Bishop of the Diocese of Dallas, Bishop Edward J. Burns.
